Equipment rebates

You can receive a rebate for a variety of energy efficient devices, such as programmable thermostats, Wi-Fi enabled thermostats, furnace and boilers. Rebates are only eligible for qualifying products with certain

specifications. See a list of qualifying products at their website.

Vectren also offers discounts for upgrading insulation and air sealing. If you complete more than one of the qualified upgrades, you can receive a bonus discount.

Online audit

Vectren offers an online home energy audit tool. The audit uses information from your bill and makes recommendations for improving your energy efficiency. You must have a Vectren online account to use this program.

Project TEEM (Teaching Energy Efficiency Measures)

TEEM is a weatherization program that assists income-eligible customers by upgrading insulation or installing a new natural gas furnace at no cost. The Community Action Partnership of the Greater Dayton Area administers the program for Ohio counties served by Vectren. Eligible customers must have an annual family income at or below 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Once qualified, customers

will receive an energy audit that can improve your energy efficiency. Interested customers should contact the Community Action Partnership at 1-800-617-2673.
