DAYTON POWER & LIGHT ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS



Dayton Power and Light (DP&L) offers several energy efficiency programs for its customers. Complete information about these programs is available online at www.dpandl.com/save-money/ or via telephone at 1-800-433-8500. These programs are only available to DP&L customers. Energy efficiency programs are subject to change. For the latest availability information and eligibility requirements, contact DP&L.

Appliance Recycling

DP&L can recycle your old refrigerator or freezer. The appliance must be in working condition and 10-30 cubic feet in size. Call 1-877-889-4765 to schedule an appointment for pickup. Recycling and pickup is offered at no cost. You can receive \$50 per appliance and an additional \$20 if you have an old room air conditioner or dehumidifier.

Lighting discounts

DP&L offers discounts on LED lightbulbs at participating retail stores. For a complete list of participating retailers, visit DP&L's website or call 866-668-9581. You can also shop for lightbulbs at DP&L's website, www.energyfederation.org/dayton.

Heating and cooling rebates

You can earn a \$100 to \$1,600 incentive by replacing heating and cooling units in your homes. You can earn an additional \$20-\$50 incentive by installing a Wi-Fi enabled thermostat. After the new system is installed, a participating contractor will

submit the rebate application on your behalf and DP&L will mail you a rebate check. For a list of qualifying heating and cooling systems, visit DP&L's website. For more information or to find a contractor, call 1-877-230-6937.

Insulation and Air Sealing Rebates

If you are looking to seal leaks or insulate your home, consider working with one of DP&L's approved contractors. The contractors can provide \$150 to \$350 in rebates for the air sealing or insulation service right on your invoice.

Smart Energy Community Program

If you qualify for the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) or Percentage of Income Payment Program (PIPP Plus), you may be able to receive energy efficiency improvements at no cost. You can receive an energy audit that can provide recommendations for improving your energy efficiency. You may be eligible to receive efficient lightbulbs, water efficient shower heads, faucet aerators or insulation. For more information, contact your community action agency at www.oaca.org.
