

The Summer Crisis Program is available July 1 through September 30 to households at or below 175% of the federal income guidelines that also meet ONE of the following requirements:

- A household member is 60 or older; OR
- A member of the household has a medical necessary condition certified by a qualified medical professional, OR
- The household has an electricity disconnection notice, has been shut off, or new electric service is being established.

The program is also available to electric consumers of investor-owned utilities, municipal utilities, and rural electric co-ops.
