

## THE HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (HEAP) CAN HELP!

HEAP is a federally funded program to help income-eligible households with winter heating costs. Households at or below 175% of the federal income level (see chart) may receive a credit once per winter heating season towards their primary heating source—electric, natural gas, or bulk fuel.

## Three ways to apply until May 31, 2026:

- Appointment with your local Energy Assistance Provider/community action agency
- Mail in an Energy Assistance application\* from <u>www.energyhelp.ohio.gov</u>
